Dear Parents and Guardians,

Please bear with us as we coordinate with our school unions and towns about bussing this year. Since we do not own or run the busses, normally we are not involved at all. However, it is easiest for us to communicate with all our parents, so we are sending this out. We have been working on this with our towns this week.

In order to get on a bus this year, each student will need to certify that they have done the Covid symptom prescreening. This is separate from the smartphone app we will use for entrance to GSA. More info on that is forthcoming.

Students will need to give the bus driver a ticket each morning in order to get on the bus. Once the unions have printed cards available, we will distribute them to students. Until then, a printable ticket is available on the GSA website here:
