Dear Parents and Guardians,

As there have been a number of questions about this in the last few days, I want to send out our policy for out-of-state travel and return to school. This is not a change from what we have been doing.

GSA Out-of-State Travel Policy

Anyone returning from a non-exempt state (meaning any state except New Hampshire or Vermont), must either quarantine for ten days, or quarantine for five days before getting a PCR test (this allows sufficient incubation time for the virus, which means the test is most likely to be accurate). If the test is negative, the person can return to campus immediately.

We have established this policy following guidelines published by the Federal and Maine CDCs, and upon the recommendation of our school physician.
