

MILITARY RECRUITMENT NOTIFICATION FORM

Dear Parents/Guardians of 11th grade students:

As you are probably aware, we are required by the federal government to supply, names, addresses and phone numbers of juniors and seniors to military recruiters, upon request, under the *No Child Left Behind Act of 2001*. We typically receive a request each year shortly after school begins. It has never been our practice at the Academy to provide information about our students to any agency or college and we will not do so at this time without first notifying parents. Each parent has the right to “opt out” of this requirement if they do not want this information disclosed.

Accordingly, we would like you to indicate below if you want us to disclose your student’s name, address and phone number to military recruiters by completing the appropriate box and returning this letter to us. If we do not receive a response from you by September 18th, we will disclose your student’s information if requested as required by Federal law.
